

**Erik Gómez-Baggethun** is a Professor of Environmental Governance at the Norwegian University of Life Sciences (NMBU), Senior Scientific Advisor at the Norwegian Institute for Nature Research (NINA), and Senior Visiting Research Associate at the University of Oxford. His research focuses on ecological economics and environmental policy, themes in which he has published over 100 articles and book chapters for international journals and edited volumes. He is vice president of the European Society for Ecological Economics, was a lead author of the report 'The Economics of Ecosystems and Biodiversity' (TEEB), and has served as an expert for the Intergovernmental Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES).

Erik will give a keynote lecture on the challenges and controversies around the commodification of ecological restoration policy, including carbon offsetting, habitat banking, and biodiversity trading.
